#### TV Channel 33 – TSL Page 1 – All Sessions

Timing Page 1 shows overall classification for all classes with lap and sector times, position 1 - 30

#### TV Channel 123 – TSL Page 2 – All Sessions

Timing Page 2 shows overall classification for all classes with lap and sector times, position 31 - 60

#### TV Channel 125 – TSL Page 3 – All Sessions

Timing Page 3 shows pit stop information for each car on a scrolling page. Driver in and out are shown as well as a running clock which is started when a car triggers pit in timing loop. The elapsed time in the pits will be displayed in red if a car's pit stop time is less than the minimum allowed

#### TV Channel 128 – TSL Combined Pages

Timing Page shows a combined screen for;

1. Overall Classification 1 – 30 - All Sessions
2. Race Control Messages - All Sessions
3. Scrolling screen – All Sessions
4. Tracking Map - All Sessions
