**-Announcement-**

Fanatec GT World Challenge Asia Series Powered by AWS 2022 shall be held as International status in accordance with the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) International Sporting Code, its Appendices, National Sporting Code and its appendices by Japan Automobile Federation (JAF). This Supplementary Regulations is also governed by Fanatec GT World Challenge Asia Sporting Regulations 2022, and 2022 Fuji Speedway General Competition Rules.

The Supplementary Regulations precedes the above regulations.

**i) Administration Check**

Where and how to apply the race, due date, participating fee are bound by the Series Regulations.

**j) Race duration and Maximum number of race car**

60 minutes/race and 45 cars

**k) Starting Procedure**

Rolling Start - Pole car is located inside of front row (ahead of 2nd grid and right next to the 1st grid)

**l) Red Flag Line**

When the race is interrupted with the Red Flag, all cars must immediately stop racing and follow marshals' instruction with a stoppable speed at any time, then back to the Red Flag line.

Red Flag Line:

Qualifying and practice sessions: At the designated work area on the pit lane.

Race: All cars enter the Fast Lane on the pit lane and line up at the Pit Exit in single file. The 'Control Line', described in the clause 47 in the Sporting Regulations, denotes 'Starting Line'. In the case of Red Flagging during the races, Article 47 of the Series Regulations shall be followed.

**m) Transponder**

Transponder is installed in accordance with the clause 19.3 in the Series Regulations.

**n) Rules on Fuel and Refueling in the race**

In case the team would need to store fuel in the pit garage, it should be up to 200 L/pit, and must be filled in steel tank. The team must use the fuel specified by the series promotor (SRO).

Refueling is prohibited in the race in accordance with clause 37.1 in the Series Regulations

**o) # of Maximum Pit Crew**

The maximum # of pit crew is specified in the clause 36.5 in the Series Regulations.

**p) White Line operation at the pit entry road/exit and Speed Limit on the Pit lane**

1. Pit road

A part of race track is separated with a demarcation line (the White Line) for cars coming in and going out of the pit road. It is prohibited to cross the White Line when a race car enters and exits from the pit lane. While cars running on the home straight, overtaking with protruding the white line along the concrete wall or the dotted line around the pit lane exit are regarded as a dangerous driving act even if their all 4 tyres were not off the track.

2. Pit lane speed limit

Pit lane is limited to 50km/h.

**q) Credentials (Identification) and Car Access Pass**

1. Once the entry is accepted, Credentials and Car Access Pass shall be issued to the team staff, drivers, their cars, their transporter and service vehicles. These Credentials must be carried and be visible at all times. Car Access Pass must be noted the license plate number and be attached on the front window screen for easy observation. It is strictly prohibited to transfer or lend Credentials and Passes to others. Any breaches to this may lead to disqualification of the competition and may be charged other penalties. (Drivers must also carry the Credentials when they are not in the sessions).

2. Any traffic in the Paddock is limited within the indicated area on the Credentials and Car Passes. However, vehicles may be transported (driven) in the designated route and be parked only at the designated parking space, and never impede emergency or other

vehicle paths.

**r) Penalty Stop / Drive Through Penalty**

When a driver would take a penalty upon obstructing incident (incl. false start) in the race, black board with penalty type and car number is presented at the Control Line. The penalty is also announced from the pit speakers at the same time.

**1. Drive Through Penalty**

Driver must enter the pit lane and exit from the pit without stopping at his/her own pit.

**2. Penalty Stop and Go**

Driver must enter the pit lane and stop in front of his/her designated garage.

**s) Safety car line**

When the Safety Car is intervened, the Safety Car Lines are operated in accordance with section 2.10.10 in the Appendix H to the International Sporting Code. This is also listed at clause 33.2.(7) in the Fuji General Competition Rules.

**t) Pit area**

We call “Garage Area” between the garage wall and the 2.5m boundary line (the Yellow line), and beyond that as “Working Area” on the concrete surface, and as “Fast lane” on the asphalt surface.

Drivers must have a valid insurance of more than JPY 9 million and pit crew must have a valid insurance of more than JPY 4 million. Also, the Organizer is obliged to take out race incident insurance with JPY 1 million or more per person to all marshal staff on the track and its vicinity.
